In Home Case or Family Service Case  
**Safety**

**Children are, first and foremost, protected from abuse and neglect**

What does the worker know about the physical and emotional safety of the child in his/her home? How have the parents protective capacities changed? Have you interviewed all children who are verbal in the home? Is the In Home Safety Plan adequate to manage child safety? Has the parent or legal guardian stated that they continue to be agreeable to the services in the ongoing safety plan? Are the parents or legal guardians cooperating in services provided as prescribed by the ongoing safety plan? Is the parent or legal guardian cooperating with all participants in the ongoing safety plan? Is the parent or legal guardian participating in the actions and the time requirements of the ongoing safety plan? Is the parent or legal guardian meeting the expectations detailed in the ongoing safety plan? Have you made contact with the Safety Service Providers? Can safety services be changed to be less intrusive? Have there been any new allegations of abuse or neglect and if so, how have they been addressed? If the child is visiting with a non-custodial parent, how are any safety concerns during visitation addressed?

**Well-Being**

**Families have an enhanced capacity to provide for their children's needs**

What is the progress toward the expected outcomes? Has there been an assessment of the needs and services of the child (ren), mother, and father? What was the process used to complete the assessment of the families needs? Has the assessment been captured in the case plan? Were there appropriate services provided to meet the identified needs? Are service providers providing timely feedback to determine child safety and progress toward expected outcomes? Were there any unmet needs? How were the child (ren), mother, and father involved in case planning and if they were not, why not? What has the frequency and location of face to face visits been with the child, mother and?

If the case is a Family Services case or was opened due to issues around education needs of the child, have there been efforts to assess the child (ren)'s Educational needs? Have services been provided to meet those needs? Are there any unmet educational needs?

If the case is a Family Services case or was opened due to issues around medical needs of the child, have there been efforts to assess the child (ren)'s medical needs? Have the child (ren) had a medical and or dental check up? Have services been provided to meet those needs? Are there any unmet medical or dental needs?

IF the case is a Family Services case or was opened due to issues around mental health needs of the child, has the child had a mental health screening? Have services been provided to meet the child (ren)'s mental health needs? Has there been a review of the child (ren)'s psychotropic medication? Are there any unmet mental health needs?
