

- Coordinated Care Organizations are coming! CCO's improve the delivery of health care to OHP and Medicaid recipients by providing integrated, comprehensive care. CCO's may be able to take OHP enrollees as early as August 2012!
- Initial Win determination workshops are starting in May. These are the first steps in creating the program that will replace CAPI.
- The OPA Rules team has demonstrated progress towards an online application equivalent to forms OHP 7210 and DHS 415F. The team is working with representatives across DHS to ensure the most accurate, applicable eligibility questions are used.

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Initial Win:

- With the Initial Win charter passed, work has begun on determining features and processes to build into the Initial Win solution that will replace CAPI.
- Determination workshops will begin in mid-May.
- The Business Transition Team will be in communication with Field Service and Central Office Units to identify workshop participants.

OPA Rules:

- Strong progress has been made towards rules determinations for the online application.
- The online app demonstrated will provide online access to forms OHP 7210 and DHS 415F in an integrated fashion.
- A demonstration of the online app was given on May 8th to representatives spanning APD, SSP, and Central Services. Lots of good feedback and adjustments came out of the demo!

HIX-IT:

- Due to the importance and short deadline on CCO implementation, the HIX-IT management team has been restructured. Both the MaX director, Rus Hargreaves, and the HIX-IT Project Manager, Pete Mallord, have been repositioned. The interim MaX director is Monte Burke.
- Business Transition is documenting the way eligibility and enrollment is currently done. It will then be mapped to the way work will be done on the new HIX-IT portal. Field and central office staff are providing input to this process mapping.
