Overview

Description: Describes required actions of an employee who has a workers' compensation claim and his or her supervisor.

Purpose/Rationale: Returning an employee to a transitional work assignment while recovering from a work-related injury reduces medical, disability and premium costs, and positively impacts an employee's recovery.

Applicability: All DHS employees.

Failure to Comply: Failure to comply with the provisions of the policy can result in higher (workers' compensation) claims costs, other costs to the organization and potential loss of skilled employees. An injured worker's failure to comply with provisions set forth in this policy may result in losing rights to reemployment and reinstatement as described in the Oregon Department of Administrative Services policy number 50.020.03, Reinstatement and Reemployment of Injured Workers.
