Rules in the Domestic Violence Fund set of rules are being amended and repealed to streamline the rules. Contract requirements will instead be listed in the RFPs and grant contracts. The revised grant process language clarifies we are doing grants, not contracts and allows DHS flexibility to do joint proposals with other funding agencies. This will reduce workload for service providers. These rules will also be changed to reflect new Department terminology and to correct formatting and punctuation.
