**Message:**

On August 1, 2012, eight Coordinated Care Organizations (CCO) will begin serving local communities.

CCOs are a new type of health plan, combining local networks of physical and mental health providers. Physical health and mental health Managed Care Organizations (MCO) will be joining together to create CCOs. Dental care will be included by January, 2014.

- **Members currently enrolled** in a physical health MCO that is becoming a CCO will be moved into the new CCO on August 1, 2012;
- During the transition, **these MCOs will close to new enrollment** as of July 18, 2012;
- As of July 18, 2012, MCOs that are becoming a CCO **will not display** as options for enrollment. On August 1, 2012, the new CCO name will display on the enrollment screen;

- **New members** found eligible on or after July 18, 2012, who have selected an MCO that is becoming a CCO on August 1, 2012, will remain on an open card until August 1, 2012, when the CCO opens to accept new members. They will be automatically enrolled into the CCO on or after August 1, 2012;
- If a member has selected a plan that does not display as an enrollment option because it is becoming a CCO on August 1, 2012, workers should not enroll the member into any plan. They will be automatically enrolled into the CCO on or after August 1, 2012;
- On August 1, 2012, workers will be able to manually enroll members into the available CCO, or allow the members to be auto-assigned.

Coordinated Care Organizations are the preferred delivery system. As of August 1, 2012, all remaining MCOs in areas where a CCO is available will close to new enrollment, contingent on CCO capacity. Once closed, members may only be enrolled into remaining MCOs if they have enrollment history with the MCO within the previous 30 days.
