**Message:** The elimination of the Third Trimester Pregnancy exemption to mandatory enrollment has been postponed. New applicants or members at redetermination may be eligible for the Third Trimester Pregnancy exemption if they meet the following criteria:

- Are in the third trimester of pregnancy; and
- Have not been enrolled in a managed care plan (Coordinated Care Organization or Managed Care Organization) for the preceding three months.

- Subject line “Third trimester pregnancy exemption request”;
- Client name, date of birth and Prime I.D.;
- CM case number;
- Estimated Due Date of delivery.

Email requests should be sent **high importance** (red exclamation point).
