In the TANF program the resource limit set at \$10,000 for all TANF applicants not serving an Intentional Program Violation (IPV), and good cause for all TANF participants in the JOBS program will continue beyond June 30, 2021. This will allow us to align with the Governor's executive order [No. 21-15](#) to support Covid-19 recovery efforts.
