Discussion/Interpretation: Supplemental income payments (SIP) issued through the Oregon Supplemental Income Program will be discontinued effective January 1, 2010. See [SPD-PT-09-023](#).

Implementation/Transition Instructions: Income of \$1.70 coded as OTH or GNT on FSMIS will be automatically removed. Income coded as OTH or GNT in the amounts of \$26.70, \$25.60, \$18.70 or \$17.60 will automatically be reduced by \$1.70.

If the SIP payment is combined with another payment (e.g. a special need), the OTH or GNT amount will need to be manually reduced at the next review or change.
