

- MAA, MAF, REF, SAC and TANF need groups which have at least one JOBS participant who is:
 - Receiving TANF and not progressing in an activity of an open JOBS case plan; or
 - Serving a current JOBS disqualification.

\$10,000 for:

- All other need groups not covered by the list above.

Examples of \$2,500 resource limit:

- Maria is on SSI. She is receiving MAA and TANF for her two children. The MAA and TANF resource limit for the family is \$2,500 because there are no caretaker relatives or parents receiving TANF.

***Reminder:** Individuals who are receiving SSI fall out of the financial group. Their income and resources should not be considered for the MAA, MAF and TANF financial eligibility decision.*

- Jane is on TANF with her children. Both of her children are in school. She has had a JOBS case plan in the past but failed to cooperate with the activities in the plan. She is currently serving a disqualification. She is at a DQ1 and will be moving to a DQ2 next month. The family's MAA and TANF resource limit is \$2,500 because Jane has a current JOBS disqualification.

Examples of \$10,000 resource limit:

- Bristol is receiving TANF for herself and her child. She is needed to care for her child who has a disability. Currently she is exempt from JOBS participation. Bristol is a parent in the need group; she is not a new applicant for MAA or TANF; she does not have a case plan and is not serving a disqualification. The MAA and TANF resource limit for the family is \$10,000;
- Harvey is a parent receiving MAA and TANF for himself and his three children. Harvey does not have a case plan at this time or a current disqualification. Using the new policy, the MAA and TANF resource limit for the family is \$10,000.

Implementation/transition instructions: Beginning January 1, 2013, follow the amended resource limits found in OAR [461-160-0015](#).

Training/communication plan: The new resource limit rule will be included as part of MAA and TANF eligibility and case management training.

Local/branch action required: Discuss transmittal and OAR change with staff who determine eligibility for MAA, MAF, REF, SAC and TANF program benefits.

Central office action required: The MAA and TANF sections of the [Family Services Manual](#) and rule are being updated effective January 1, 2013.
