

- Provided guidance on evaluating eligibility for all medical programs when current eligibility is endings. Described the pending process if additional information is needed to make a decision. MA B.5.
- Specified that the OHP-OPU program requirements were changed to limit who could be found eligible for the program. Listed the groups of medical applicants that may be considered for OHP-OPU. Examples also provided. MA E.8.

Other Medical Assistance Programs chapter changes:

- Reorganized information on verification of eligibility. Provided guidance on accepting a client’s statement when income cannot be verified. MA B.7.
- Added clarification that even though a woman must be under age 65 to be eligible for BCCM, the Breast and Cervical Cancer Program coordinated by DHS Health Services sets its own criteria that a woman must be at least 40 years old to access screening services. MA D.1. and E.14.
- Specified that a child born to a CAWEM mother is an assumed eligible newborn (AEN). MA C.1. and E.5.
- Added a new section to describe the \$10,000 income limit for an OHP financial group that includes a “principal” - a person with significant authority in a business entity. MA F.10.
- Revised the section on OHP budgeting. Added information on evaluating eligibility using the income received in the budget month when the need group includes a victim of domestic violence as allowed by rule. MA F.11.
