 - a. Pediatric emergency care guidelines for the injured and ill.
 - b. Conduct and analyze data related to prevention of injury and illness, monitoring the EMSC Program and recommending improvements where indicated.
 - c. Provide advice concerning pediatric care to healthcare facilities and other providers of healthcare.
 - d. Conduct other activities need to ensure optimal delivery of pediatric care services within the state.
2. Advise on how to establish and promote pediatric education and injury prevention programs.

Advise the EMS & Trauma Systems Section on the best way to meet the objectives of the grant, National EMSC 5-year Plan, and any applicable legislation.
