Discussion/interpretation:

This policy transmittal concerns the recent federal policy changes affecting individuals applying for Medicaid long term care services with an underlying Medicaid OHP Plus eligibility under 410-200 through the Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) Medicaid program.

Temporary Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) in chapter 411, divisions 015, 030 and 035 became effective January 1st, 2015. They state that the equity value of an individual's home must not exceed the limit set forth in OAR 461-145-0220 (currently \$552,000). Furthermore, when an individual is determined ineligible for long term care (LTC) based on the equity value of a home, a notice for being over resources is required in accordance with 461-175-0200.

MAGI does not generally consider resources in the eligibility determination. However, for LTC service eligibility, federal policy does require this one resource limit: Individuals applying for LTC services with an underlying Medicaid OHP Plus benefit package under the MAGI Medicaid program must not have an equity value of a home above the limit as described in these rules.

<u>Implementation/transition instructions</u>: Immediately begin applying the OAR criteria for MAGI eligible individuals applying for LTC services.

<u>Local/branch action required</u>: Immediately begin applying the OAR criteria for MAGI eligible individuals applying for LTC services.
