Message: As part of Oregon’s transition plan for compliance with Federal Home and Community-Based Services rules, Oregon’s rules (411-004-0040) require that Individually-Based Limitation to the Rules be formally in place by February 28, 2018. APD will officially begin implementing Limitations in July 2017.

Individually-Based Limitations to the Rules are restrictions to specific HCBS freedoms and rights that can only be considered if the individual’s own or another person’s health and safety are at risk. Even under those circumstances, the individual or their legal representative must agree (consent) to the limitation.

We will provide training to Case Managers, APS workers, Licensors, Managers and others interested in May and June.
