Effective February 1, 2017, the Adult Foster Home rates will increase as part of the Department's collective bargaining agreement with SEIU. APD Central Office will make all changes necessary to implement these rate changes. This includes a change to the Hourly Exceptional Rate for AFH providers.

The Homecare Workers hourly wage will increase February 1, 2017.
