Mental Illness AND Developmental Disability

If you were to Google the headline above you would ultimately get information on individuals with both a developmental disability and mental illness.



Over 90% of the individuals we serve have co-existing disorders of mental illness and developmental disabilities. It's important to know that mental illness and developmental disability are two distinctly different processes occurring at different times in a persons' life. Developmental disabilities such as Autism, Aspergers, or Pervasive Developmental Disorder occur at infancy or in childhood years where as mental illness occur in adulthood. The typical onset of mental illness occurs between the years of 18 – 21. While symptoms may be present as a child/adolescent, mental illness disorders such as Schizophrenia and Bipolar disorder cannot be diagnosed until adulthood. Next time, we will learn a little more about the different disorders of mental illness.
