## **State Operated Community Program (SOCP) SOCP Operating Guidelines**



**Guideline Title:** Injury Observation

**Effective Date:** 06/25/2007

- 1. "Body Checks" will not be conducted by staff to determine if injuries have occurred
- 2. Injury observations may occur during the natural course of the clients day when dressing or bathing
- 3. Clients will not have times during the day set aside for staff to check them for injuries
- 4. Clients that have frequent injuries will have their injuries monitored and documented through form <a href="DHS 4623">DHS 4623</a>, <a href="SOCP Injury Tracking">SOCP Injury Tracking</a>.
- 5. If clients have fallen, been in a restraint, or an event has occurred that may have caused an injury, staff will immediately check for injuries and if no initial injuries are observed, then they will follow the above procedures.

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
