APD-IM-16-106	12/12/16	Online training on Dementia & Serious Mental Illness - Two staff training modules focused on support for individuals with dementia and serious mental illness are now available on-line. The two new modules build on training developed over the past 2 years for ADRC staff and partners as part of an Administration for Community Living grant focused on increasing Oregon's capacity to address the growing impact of dementia across systems. 		OAR 461-115-0020 clarifies the application and any additional information required for application and recertification be received by the Department to complete the application process.
		OAR 461-120-0345 establishes in rule those not entitled to no-cost Part A Medicare coverage and, either ineligible for QMB-BAS or without a service payment which allows the full premium amount as a deduction, are not required to pursue it; establishes Tri-Care coverage must be pursued.
		OAR 461-130-0310 divides the SNAP E&T exemption criteria list into two parts First: exemptions from work registration for chronically homeless must be tied to an inability to obtain employment. Second: activities due to employment or participation in another E&T program are not exempt from work registration and the other E&T eligibility requirements; they are required to accept bon afide job offers and to maintain employment.
		OAR 461-130-0315 clarifies which requirements apply to SNAP clients who are required to register for work.
		OAR 461-135-0730 makes SMF (QI-1) unavailable to individuals receiving OSIPM.
		OAR 461-135-0820 clarifies widow and widower entitlement for Medicare Part A and the requirement to stay under the income and resource limits for OSIPM in the absence of Title II benefits.
		OAR 461-140-0296 updates the amount used to calculate the number of months of ineligibility due to a disqualifying transfer of assets. This amount is calculated by using the average monthly cost to a private patient of nursing facility services in Oregon.
		OAR 461-145-0005 states in the OSIP, OSIPM, and QMB programs payments made under the Agent Orange Act or

		liability litigation are excluded.  OAR 461-145-0930 includes mileage reimbursements to countable self-employment income.
		OAR 461-150-0050 states for OSIP, OSIPM, and QMB all income is counted in the month received, not excluded if received prior to application.
