<u>SS-PT-16-013</u>	6/15/16	JOBS Re-engagement and Disqualification rule changes effective 7/1/2016 - See transmittal for details.
<u>SS-PT-16-014</u>	6/15/16	EBT Replacement Exception Criteria - The updated manual section asks for certain exceptions, the branch first review the remaining balance on the account and evaluate if a delay due to mailing a card from the replacement unit would jeopardize a household member or not. This change will increase the number of EBT replacement cards that contain the name of the authorized individual, bringing us into compliance with HB2392.
<u>SS-PT-16-015</u>	6/15/16	EBT Restriction Change - Effective July 1, 2016 TANF cash benefits may not be used or accessed in any EBT transaction in a: Marijuana Dispensary; see transmittal for details.
<u>SS-IM-16-031</u>	6/15/16	Child support sanction notices - Effective July 1, 2016, workers will no longer have to manually generate child support sanction notices for CS1 to CS4. See transmittal for details.
<u>SS-IM-16-032</u>	6/15/16	Condom Storage – SSP branch offices currently have latex condoms available for customers who need them. See transmittal for details.
<u>SS-IM-16-033</u>	6/15/16	ERDC income calculations and coding - A recent Secretary of State audit of the child care program identified errors in 13 out of 60 cases sampled. This equals 22% of cases in error resulting in \$1,033,640 of likely questioned costs. This puts the ERDC program at risk for loss of federal funding. . See transmittal for details.
