<u>APD-PT-16-</u> <u>019</u>	5/13/16	Procedure Change: MAGI Referral Application Processing - The procedure for mailing application materials to individuals referred to APD from Branch 5503 following MAGI closures, denials, or service requests has changed. A 539H should be mailed only if (and after) a completed and signed application has been submitted, the interview completed, and the branch has determined further information or documentation is required. The cover letter on the <u>ACA Procedure Document</u> is sufficient to include with the 539A application. See transmittal for details.

The eligibility requirements for SEBTC are that the child is eligible to receive free or reduced-price school lunches, is 5 to 19 years of age and resided in one of the approved school districts.
